In the Supreme Court of Victoria

In the Will of Daniel Redenbach late of Tambo Upper in the State of Victoria Farmer deceased this is the Will marked A produced and shewn to August Daniel Redenbach and Arthur Jacob Redenbach at the time of swearing their affidavit before me this 1st day of November 1918.

A Commissioner of the Supreme Court of Victoria for taking affidavits.

This is the Last Will and Testament of me Daniel Redenbach of Tambo Upper in Victoria Farmer Whereof I Appoint my sons August Daniel Redenbach Arthur Jacob " " Redenbach (Ernest George Redenbach and Reynold Theodore Redenbach) all of Tambo Upper aforesaid farmers Executors and Trustees (hereinafter called my said trustees) I Give and Bequeath to my dear wife Mary Elizabeth Redenbach the sum of Three hundred pounds which sum shall be absolutely vested in her on my death and shall carry interest after the rate of Four pounds per centum per annum until payment thereof All the rest residue and remainder of my real and personal estate of whatsoever kind and wheresoever situate (hereinafter called my remaining real and personal estate) I Give Devise and Bequeath unto my said trustees Upon Trust to sell call in and convert the same into money with the full discretion to my said trustees of absolute owners as to the time and manner of such sale calling in and conversion Until such sale calling in and conversion I empower my said trustees to let from year to year or for any term or terms of years and upon any terms and conditions which my said trustees shall think proper or to occupy use and manage my said remaining real and personal estate and the affairs thereof generally I Declare that the rents dividends interests and other yearly produce of my said remaining real and personal estate respectively to accrue due after my decease and until the actual sale calling in and conversion thereof shall be deemed the annual income thereof I Direct that my said wife shall be entitled

to receive annually one fourth of the said income and the remaining three fourths shall be divided equally between all my children (subject in each year as ^{to} the whole of the said income ^{to} of the payments & of current expenses) I Direct that my said trustees shall stand possessed of the net moneys to arise from the sale calling in and conversion of my said remaining real and personal estate (after paying and retaining thereout my just debts and my funeral and testamentary expenses) Upon Trust as to one fourth thereof to invest the same upon any of the investments authorized by law in Victoria with power from time to time to vary the investments and to pay the annual income thereof to my said wife during her life and upon her death to divide the same (both capital and income thereof) between all my children forthwith. And Upon Trust as to the ^(after such sale calling in and conversion) DM remaining three-fourths thereof to forthwith divide the same equally between all my children I Direct that if in any year during my said wife's life the annual income or share of income payable to her annually as aforesaid (exclusive of the said sum of Three hundred pounds and any interest thereon) do not amount to the sum of Forty pounds then my said trustees shall make the same up to Forty pounds out of the capital of the said remaining real and personal estate or the capital of the one fourth part of the proceeds thereof invested as aforesaid I Declare that if any child of mine shall die in my life-time leaving a child or children who shall survive me and being a son or sons shall attain the age of twenty-one years or

being a daughter or daughters shall attain that age or marry
 then and in every such case the last mentioned child
 or children shall take (and if more than one equally
 between them) the share which his her or their parent
 would have taken in the aforesaid trust moneys if
 such parent had survived me Lastly I revoke all
 former wills and testamentary dispositions and declare
 this to be my only last will and testament In
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this
 eighteenth day of March One thousand nine
 hundred and eleven
