Elisabeth Mickan the youngest child of Andreas and Anna Mickan, was eight years old when she moved with her parents to Bethel, N.S.W., and some years later to Walla Walla, N.S.W.

On September 3, 1884 in the Evangelical Lutheran Church, Walla Walla, N.S.W., Elisabeth married John Traugott Pannach. Pastor T.I. Egen officiated and witnessed by Johann Mickan and Johann Wenke. John Traugott Pannach was born at Ebenezer, S.A. and was a farmer. The first years of their married life the couple lived at Walla Walla.

In 1891-1892 Traugott together with Joseph Wiesner and Ernst Mickan, started a meat delivery service to the gang working on the Culcairn-Corowa railway line.

Early in 1898 Elisabeth, Traugott and their first four children moved to Queensland, and became pioneer settlers in the Linthorpe district near Mount Tyson. His son helped him clear the dense scrub on approximately eighty-one hectares of rich soil on the southern side of the Darling Downs basin. Pittsworth was their main town, a distance of approximately twenty-two kilometres.

The marriage was blessed with six children, three sons and three daughters, a son Bernhard Traugott Pannach died when a child in 1901, and is buried in the Aubigny Lutheran Cemetery, Queensland.

Hermine Elisabeth was born at Walla Walla near Albury, N.S.W. and baptised by Pastor Simpfendorfer. At the age of ten years, she came to the Linthorpe District near Mt. Tyson, Queensland with her parents. Completed her education at Linthorpe. In 1901 she was confirmed at Aubigny Lutheran Church by Pastor W. Guhr.

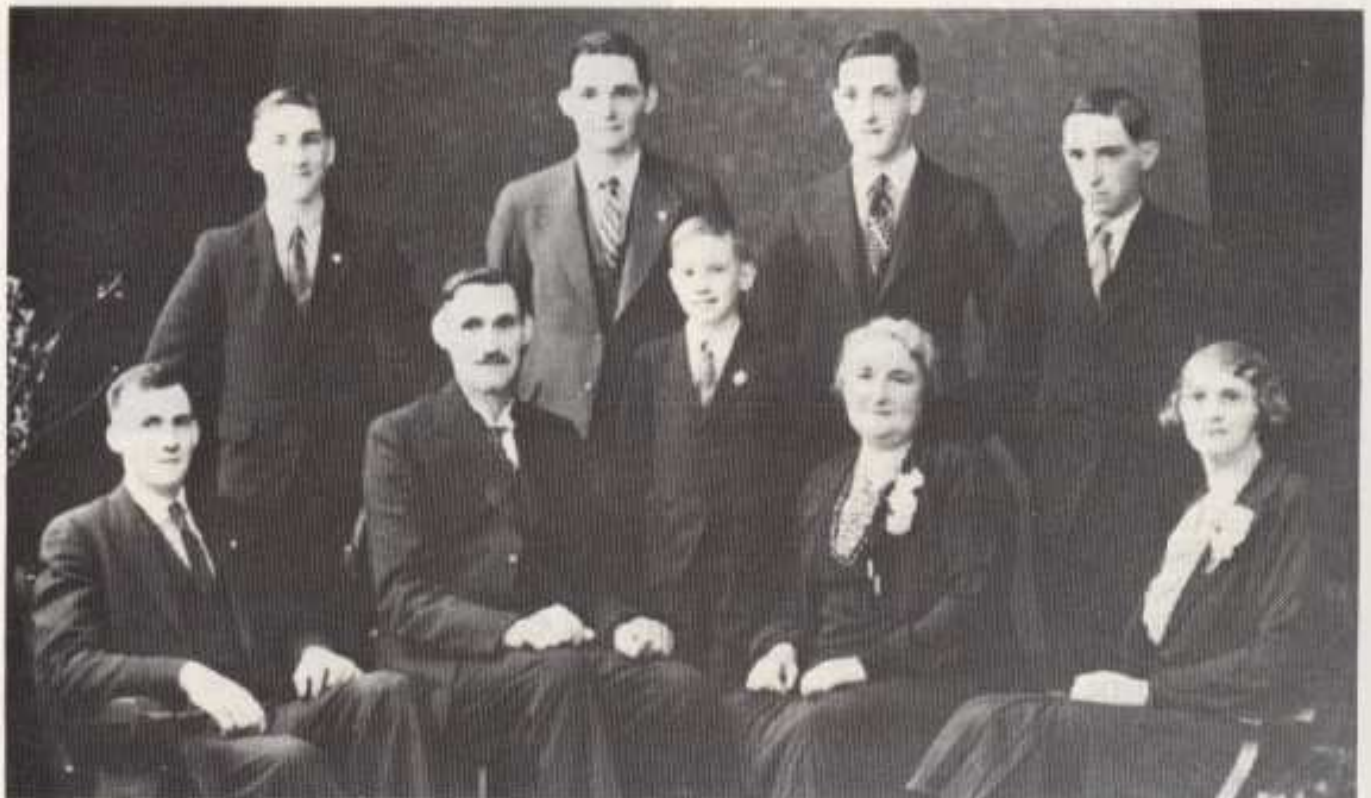
On September 27, 1911, Hermine Elisabeth married Friedrich Carl Wilhelm Kummerow, who was born and educated at Toowoomba, Queensland and moved to Linthorpe where he dairy farmed for a number of years in grass

and scrub country. They were among the early settlers of Linthorpe, cultivating thirty acres with a single furrow plough with horses. Horses and sulky were used for transport. In 1927 they bought their first car, a Plymouth.

In 1932 with a firm belief in the potential of plain country for extensive grain growing, Fred Kummerow purchased land at Bongeene where, with the first band of wheat-growers, he played a large part in establishing what is today a thriving grain growing industry at Bongeene.

They dairy farmed in the early years then grew wheat, farming with horses successfully. With his wife he retired in Pittsworth, Queensland in 1953. Mr. Fred Kummerow handed on the love of the land to his six sons, four of whom Ray, Howard, Alan and Bernie are grain growers in the Bongeene and Norwin areas, Ted has a grain, sheep and cattle property at Tara, and Andrew has a grain and cattle property at Chinchilla, all living in Queensland.

The marriage was blessed with seven children, one daughter and six sons.

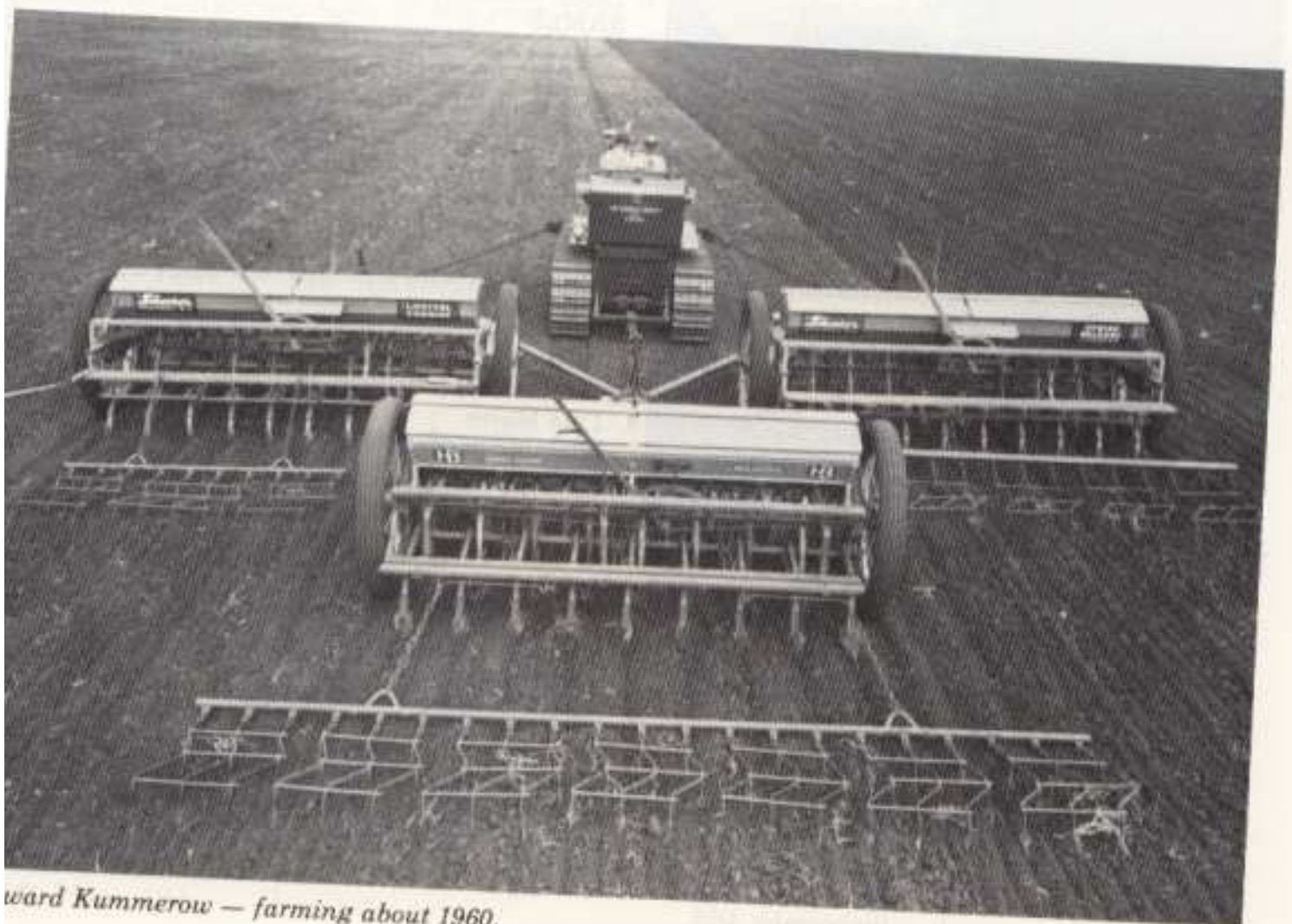

Andrew Samuel Pannach accompanied his parents to Linthorpe, Qld., in the year 1898. Andrew was one of the first pupils to enrol at the Linthorpe State School which opened in the year 1900. At an early age he left school to help his Father clear the dense scrub. He farmed this land until the end of his life. The original home of his parents was destroyed by fire in 1942, and was replaced with a new home in 1946. On June 21, 1922, Andrew married Elizabeth Tews in the Methodist Church, Springside.

Their general living was derived from farm produce, cereal growing, dairying, cream and pigs.

The marriage was blessed with four children.

Alfred John Pannach was only three months old when his parents moved to Queensland and settled on a farm in the Mt. Tyson district. It was here where Alfred, his sisters Elizabeth, Lydia and brother Andrew received their primary education. His parents and the children went regularly to worship services in the Aubigny Lutheran Church. Alfred received confirmation instructions by Pastor Appelt, and was confirmed on November 9, 1913.

After assisting his Father on the farm for several years, he realized that the farm was

not large enough to occupy three adults. Alfred decided to go back to N.S.W. to the district where his parents had lived for a few years. Here he worked as a farmhand for several farmers in the Alma Park and Pleasant Hills districts for a number of years. According to reports, Alfred was a reliable and competent farmhand and worked a long time for Johann Kotzur at Alma Park.

After his marriage to Adeline Hilda Fischer in Salem Lutheran Church, Alma Park, on July 5, 1926, Alfred received employment on "Round Hill" station, a short distance east of Culcairn. They lived in a cottage on the property for a number of years before they went to Culcairn to live in retirement. Alfred died in the Culcairn Hospital at the age of eighty-two years. The burial took place in the Culcairn Cemetery after a service in St. Andrew's Uniting Church.

Tyson State School and later after winning a scholarship, Pittsworth High School for two years. It was her burning ambition in those days to be a school teacher but circumstances, which

included the death of her Mother, prevented this. Her first job was in the office of the Mt. Tyson Cheese Factory. She rode a horse to work.

When Esther was nineteen she went with her Father to live at Highgate Hill in Brisbane. It was in Brisbane on January 30, 1926, that Esther and John George Willson, whom she first met when she was seventeen, were married by the late Pastor Theo. Reimers.

They lived for a while in Toowoomba but finally settled with their three sons in Brisbane, at 8 Garfield Street, Toombul. "Jack" Willson was a motor mechanic and worked for many years in the garage of Owen

Gardner Pty. Ltd. (soft drink manufacturers). He was a keen fisherman. The family spent most holidays by the sea, especially at Caloundra. Music played a big part in their lives. Both Deryck and Raymond sang with a local opera society and Esther still is very fond of listening to fine music.

Esther still owns the family home but after her husband died in November 1975, she was only able to stay on there for another five years, as owing to failing eyesight and indifferent health she could no longer manage by herself. She now lives at Trinder Park Lutheran Rest Home. Esther is still very much the centre of her family. She takes a great interest in all of their activities and never forgets a birthday or anniversary. Recently she attended grand-daughter Cynthia's wedding to Alan Hayton and is very happy that the newly-weds are now living in her old home. Another event of late which has given her much joy is the graduation of another grand-daughter Sylvia, as a primary and pre-school teacher, as she feels in some way her own ambition of teaching has been fulfilled.

Her sons, their wives, her grand-children and one great grand-daughter are all very dear to her, as is her church and her God, to whom she gives thanks for a long full life.
