

MRS MARY ELIZABETH REDENBACH.

The death occurred at Tambo Upper, on Saturday last, of Mrs Mary Elizabeth Redenbach, at the age of 78 years. The deceased lady had lived in the Tambo Upper district for the past 53 years, where her late husband, Mr Daniel Redenbach, successfully engaged in farming and dairying pursuits. The death of Mrs Redenbach will be mourned by a large circle of friends, amongst whom she enjoyed the respect and esteem through her long life in the district into which she went in the pioneering days.
